#### KARIBA FUN RUN 2017

We would like to thank everyone for the support of the 2017 Kariba Fun Run! This event was a massive success this year with a record number of entries in both the 10km and 21 km events. Our goal was to really make this event a fun filled family weekend with the added activities of kids fishing and the movies under the stars. We also believe the Kariba community and economy benefits hugely from this event.

There was a total of 589 runners and about 110 in the kids run.

We raised a total of \$16,354, which will be donated to the Kariba Animal Welfare Fund Trust (KAWFT), The Tony Waite Organization and Greenwood Park. KAWFT do an enormous amount of work in Kariba protecting the local wildlife, which includes snare sweeps and darting sick and wounded animals. The Tony Waite Organization is also based in Kariba, they do a lot of work in the local community with HIV and AIDS prevention, treatment, care and support. Greenwood Park is managed by Harare Round Table No. 1, we have managed this park since 1964, and this provides an enjoyable place for kids to visit at minimal cost.
